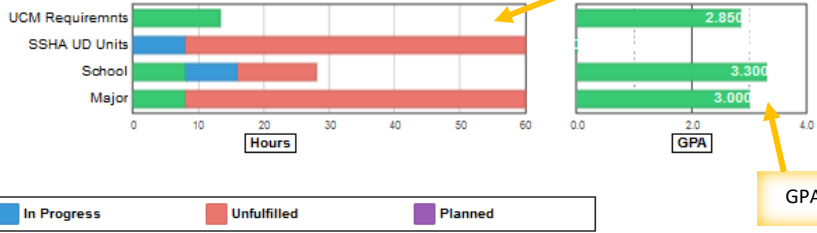

SSHA Requirements:

This has a red  next to the requirement name. This means that one or more sub-requirements have not been met.

The sub-requirement name often includes text that will help you complete the requirement. As an example, this requirement can only be met by taking courses from the SELECT FROM list.

SELECT FROM: this gives you a list of courses you can take to meet the requirement. Pay attention to the sub-requirement description.

When a course number changes or a course splits into a separate lecture and lab, you will see a PROCESSED AS comment next to the course. As an example, PSY 150 course changed to PSY 152.

NEEDS: this shows you how many more courses you need to take to meet the sub-requirement. As an example, this student needs 2 more courses from the list.

**Major Requirements:**

These are requirements specific to your major. If you intend to change your major run a what-if audit.

**IMPORTANT NOTE:**

No two audits will be alike. Requirements change based on catalog year and the order in which courses are completed could affect the way courses apply towards requirements.
